ENTRY

- 1. All players compete in one category (Primary 1-6). A team of 3 to 5 players from the same school is eligible to enter as a school team competing for the Team and Individual Awards.
- 2. To compete for team awards, a school must have at least 3 players competing all the games in the championship. When calculating team ranking and awards, only the top 3 players from each school will be counted.
- 3. Entry deadline: 30 September 2023 (Saturday)

The selection of applicants is decided on a first come, first served basis.

Players from the same school will not play against each other in the first 2 rounds.

You are strongly advised to download and read the WESPA game rules before the competition. If you have any questions about the rules, you may contact Mr Ken Kum at 2470 3363 during school hours for clarification.

The addenda below provide additional details which will be applicable specifically to this championship. These do not deviate from the WESPA rules, but rather clarify how they would be applied in our championship.

No teachers/instructors/supporters are allowed to stand around the players during the game.
 However, teachers are allowed to enter the game area to take photographs but they should not communicate with any players by any means. Student supporters should stay in the audience area during the game.

• 2.3.4 Optional Forfeiture due to Lateness

A late player whose timer has been started may elect to forfeit the game if his or her assigned game time, as calculated under Rule 2.3.2 or 2.3.3, is less than <u>5 minutes</u>.

5.3.5 Standard Game Time

An assigned game time of <u>15 minutes</u> is allowed for each player in a game in this championship. The maximum amount of time allowed for each game is <u>50 minutes</u> (including time for both players and challenges).
