<u>ENTRY</u>

- 1. All players compete in one category (Primary 1-6). A team of 3-5 players from the same school is eligible to enter as a school team competing for the Team and Individual Awards.
- 2. Entry deadline: 23 September 2019 (Monday) The selection of applicants is decided on a first come, first served basis.

FORMAT

3 games • 15 minutes per player • CSW19 5-point penalty per unsuccessfully challenged word

- 1. Each player plays 3 rounds of competitions individually. After Round 3, there will be a list of final rankings of individual players, arranged from the largest number of wins to the smallest number of wins. Spread (differences in scores between opponents) will be used to break the tie between players with the same number of wins.
- **2.** The pairings for Round 1 are randomly decided, but players from the same school will not play against each other.
- **3.** After each round, the ranking of a player is decided
 - first by the total number of wins
 - second by the accumulated spread
- **4.** For Rounds 2 and 3, the pairings are decided by the overall rankings up to the previous round, where the first-ranked player plays against the second-ranked player, the third plays against the fourth and so on.
- 5. If players from the same school are to play against each other under this system, minimal adjustments in pairings will be made so that at least the top-ranked players are guaranteed to play with opponents from other schools. For example, if the top-ranked player and the second-ranked player are from the same school, the top-ranked player will play the third-ranked player, and the second-ranked will play the fourth in the next round.
- 6. The ranking of a school team is decided
 - first by the total number of individual wins of the top 3 players of the team
 - second by the total spread of the total spread of the team.

RULES OF PLAY

Unless otherwise specified below, **WESPA game rules version 3.0** will be followed. The game rules are available at:

You are strongly advised to download and read the WESPA game rules before the competition. If you have any questions about the rules, you may contact Mr Ken Kum at 2470 3363 during school hours for clarification.

The addenda below provide additional details which will be applicable specifically to this championship. These do not deviate from the WESPA rules, but rather clarify how they would be applied in our championship.

 No teachers/instructors/supporters are allowed to stand around the players during the game. However, teachers are allowed to enter the game area to take photographs but they should not communicate with any players by any means. Student supporters should stay in the audience area during the game.

• 2.3.4 Optional Forfeiture due to Lateness

A late player whose timer has been started may elect to forfeit the game if his or her assigned game time, as calculated under Rule 2.3.2 or 2.3.3, is less than <u>5 minutes</u>.

• 3.10.13 Challenge Penalties

A five-point penalty per unsuccessfully challenged word is imposed in this championship.

• 3.11 Procedures for Issuing and Adjudicating a Challenge

There are two methods for adjudicating a challenge in this championship, namely:

- (1) <u>Self-adjudication at an external device</u> (3.11.1 (a))
- (2) <u>External adjudication via Tournament Director's smart device</u> (3.11.2 (c)) Players should call for an official, instead of the Director, for external adjudication in this championship.

• 5.3.5 Standard Game Time

An assigned game time of <u>15 minutes</u> is allowed for each player in a game in this championship. The maximum amount of time allowed for each game is <u>50 minutes</u> (including time for both players and challenges).
